

## Quick Choice

**Purpose:** Make a quick group decision.

**Supplies:** Index cards, pens

**Time:** 6 Minutes

### Flow:

Create a question for the group to answer. This could be the next action to take, or an activity, a discussion topic, or any other decision that the group needs to make.

*[ex. What would you like to see in the Thiagi Newsletter?]*



### Single Elimination Round

- Each participant write top 3 answers (actions to take) on a single index card
- Pass card to the left
- Eliminate one answer - Draw a faint line through least favorite idea
- Pass card to the left [again]
- Eliminate one answer - Draw a faint line through least favorite idea [1 remains]
- Pass card to the left [again]
- Circle one answer - the remaining idea OR 'save' an eliminated one

### Double Elimination Round

- Compare cards with a partner - put an 'x' next to the answer you like least.
- Compare cards with a new partner - write an 'x' next to the answer you like least.
- Any card with 1 or 2 x's are discarded into a pile the floor.
- Ideas with no x's are read aloud and placed around the room (floor or table)

### Final Answer

- Participants walk to and group around the card with the idea they want to explore most.
- Follow instructions on card *[ex. Create a very quick game.]*

### Notes:

Does the question need to be something that is actionable immediately? An activity for the group? That's how we used the game.
